NOTICE TO IMPORTERS AND EXPORTERS NO. 27 OF 2020

SUBJECT: PROCEDURE FOR THE EXPORTATION OF SCRAP METAL

The attention of all Exporters is drawn to the following procedure for the export of Scrap Metal.

All Exports of Scrap Metal require the permission of the **Collector** or **Supervisor** of the respective **Port** prior to exportation.

On every occasion, the Exporter of Scrap Metal shall submit to the **Collector** or **Supervisor**, the following documents:

1. Old Metal and Marine Stores Dealer's Licence
2. The paid Form e-C82 – Customs Export Declaration and Invoice with full details of consignment:
 - a. Type of Metal
 - b. Weight of metal
3. Letter to the Comptroller of Customs & Excise seeking permission to Export
4. Where applicable the Ministry of Trade Licence for the export of Non-Ferrous Metal Scrap and Ores

Upon satisfaction, the **Collector** or **Supervisor** shall grant permission for the exportation of that specific consignment of scrap metal.

The Proper Officer at all Ports of Export shall ensure that such permission is granted prior to the loading of any consignment of scrap metal on any vessel for export.

Notice to Exporters No. 1 of 2011 is hereby revoked.

Please be guided accordingly.
