NOTICE TO IMPORTERS NO. 8 OF 2021

**SUBJECT: THE EXPIRATION OF THE ANTI-DUMPING DUTY IMPOSED
ON ALUMINIUM EXTRUSIONS ORIGINATING IN THE
PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA**

The attention of all Importers is drawn to the expiration of the anti-dumping duty imposed on Aluminium Extrusions originating in the People's Republic of China.

Importers are advised that pursuant to Section 29A (6) of the Anti-Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act, Chap. 78:05, these duties expired on 20th February, 2021, the date of the fifth anniversary of the coming into effect of the Order dated 21st February, 2016.

The Notice of Expiration of the Anti-Dumping Duty imposed on Aluminium Extrusions originating in the People's Republic of China has been published as **Legal Notice No. 75 of 2021** of which a copy is attached for ease of reference.

Importers are to be guided accordingly.

NOTICE is hereby given that an Order imposing duties on—

- (a) Aluminium bars, rods and profiles of H.S. Codes 7604.10.00; 7604.21.00; and 7604.29.00; and
- (b) Aluminium tubes and pipes of H.S. Codes 7608.10.00 and 7608.20.00,

originating in the People's Republic of China came into effect on 21st February, 2016, by Legal Notice No. 30 dated 21st February, 2016 (hereinafter referred to as "the Order") and published on 3rd March, 2016 and was corrected by Legal Notice No. 43 dated 18th March, 2016 and published on 24th March, 2016.

Notice is also given that pursuant to section 29A(6) of the Anti-Dumping and Countervailing Duties Act, Chap. 78:05, these duties expired on 20th February, 2021, the date of the fifth anniversary of the coming into effect of the Order dated 21st February, 2016.
