NOTICE TO IMPORTERS NO. 11 OF 2022

SUBJECT: INFORMATION REQUIREMENTS OF TRANSIT SHED OWNERS

The Comptroller of Customs and Excise and the Minister of National Security are committed to strengthening the Nation's borders in order to combat the illegal trade of arms, ammunition and narcotics.

In keeping with this objective all owners of Transit Sheds are required to submit to the Comptroller of Customs and Excise a list of all Agents or Owners of Vessels/Carriers who are contracted to deposit their LCL containers into the Transit Shed.

The required List of Agents or Owners shall be submitted to the Comptroller of Customs and Excise by or before **23rd September, 2022**.

Please be advised that failure to provide this information shall result in all LCL containers being deposited into the Transit Shed of the Terminal Operator of the Port of Pt Lisas or the Port of Port of Spain.

The Comptroller anticipates that with your continued commitment to assist in the fight against the illegal trade of arms, ammunition and narcotics the requested information shall be submitted within the stated time.

The Comptroller remains committed to the facilitation of compliant trade in an environment of our protected Borders.

Please be guided accordingly.
