NOTICE TO IMPORTERS NO.09 OF 2025

**SUBJECT: IMPORTATION OF UNAUTHORIZED UNMANNED AERIAL
SYSTEMS (UAS)/ DRONES**

The attention of all Importers is drawn to **Notice to Importers No.12 of 2021** which outlines the requirements for the **Clearance of Drones**.


The Telecommunications Authority of Trinidad and Tobago (TATT) has advised the Division of the unauthorized sale of **Unmanned Aerial Systems (UAS)** including **drones**, without the requisite approval from the Authority.

Importers are hereby reminded that upon importation, the necessary regulatory approvals must be acquired before such devices are permitted entry into the country. Failure to adhere to these regulations could result in operations that may cause harmful interference to critical communication networks, aviation safety systems and other licensed services. All importers are urged to ensure compliance with the relevant regulations.

A copy of **Notice to Importers No.12 of 2021** is attached for ease of reference.

Importers are to be guided accordingly.

NOTICE NO. 12 OF 2021**

SUBJECT: Requirements for the Clearance of Drones


The attention of all Importers is drawn to the subject at caption.

In order to effect clearance of a drone the Importer or their Agent must present the following:

- Any **one** of the following from the Telecommunications Authority of Trinidad and Tobago (TATT):
 - (i) Equipment Certification; or
 - (ii) A letter of non-objection in lieu of Equipment Certification

Notice to Importers No. 6 of 2021 on the above captioned subject is hereby rescinded.

Importers are to be guided accordingly.
